A Word from our Past President, Dr. Alex Bruels

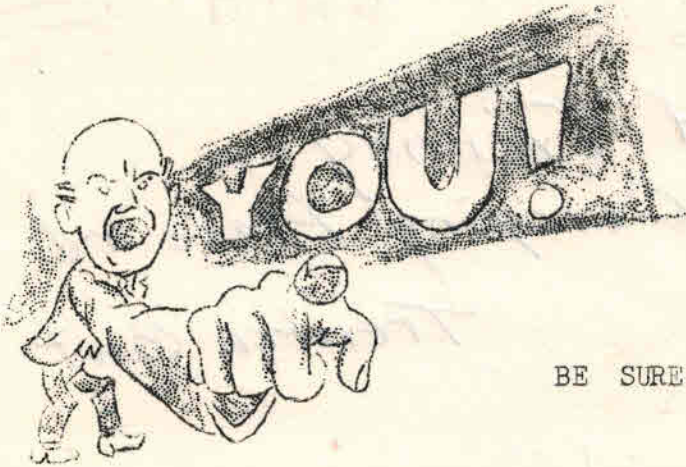
