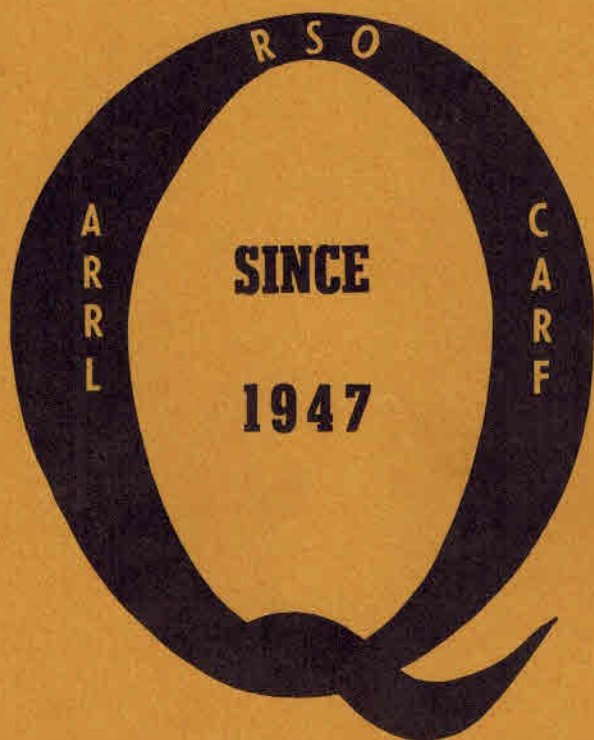

NOTICE OF MOTION

At the regular Executive Meeting of the Club on 3 Dec 1975 the subjects of Life Membership and Family Membership were discussed at great length. As a result of the discussion, certain recommendations were made to the members at the December and January general meetings. The adoption of these recommendations by the Club will require an amendment to the Club Constitution and since an amendment to the Constitution requires a majority vote of the members present at a general meeting, it was felt that the recommendations should be published in the Bulletin in the form of a Notice of Motion which will be dealt with at the February General Meeting. The Notice of Motion Follows:

It is hereby proposed that Article II/^{of the Constitution}para (a) Membership be amended by the addition of two new classes of membership as follows:

- (4) Family Membership For any family of two or more members the annual dues will be \$6.00 for the first member of the family and \$2.00 for each additional member. These amounts are subject to amendment in keeping with the amount of regular membership dues.
- (5) Life Membership There will be two ways in which to become a Life Member:
- (i) Having been a member for 20 consecutive years, a person may purchase a Life Membership by paying two years dues at the current rate .
 - (ii) A person may purchase a Life Membership at any time by paying 15 years dues in advance at the rate of dues in force at the time of purchase.

(i.e. at the present time 15 X \$6.00 or \$90.00)
