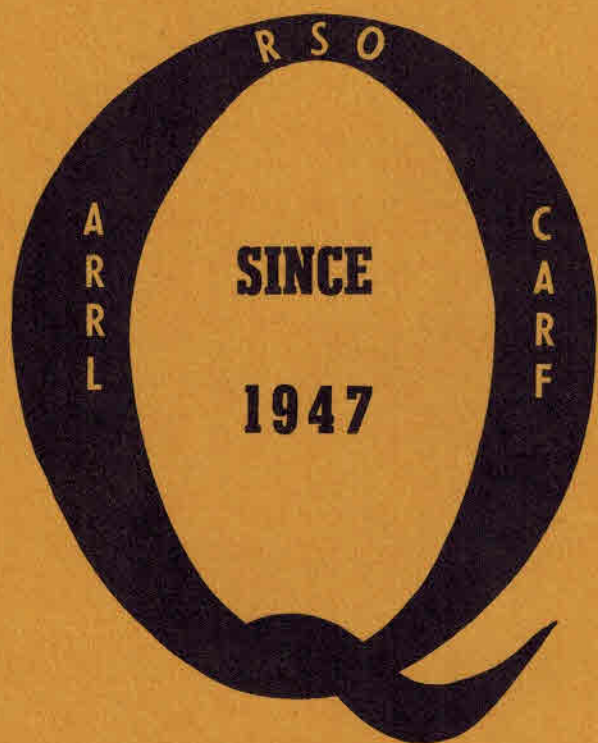

For those of you looking for an antenna that conserves space on the tower for 2 meter use, take a look at the Cush Craft 10 element beams. The 144-20T is an Oscar antenna which provides vertical, horizontal, axial, right circular and left circular polarization as well as Horizontal and vertical at the same time. The 147-20T is the same type with separate leads for either or both Vertical & Horizontal. On this one, both lead-in cables come into the shack for use on FM and the low end of the band. Just the thing for sideband on the low end and FM above 146. The elements are all on one boom. VE3RL is about to put this antenna up.

Sinclair have moved into the "HAM" antenna field with the new "Rapier". A 2 meter 10 Ft. spike of fibreglass with 3 DB over a dipole and 6 DB over a groundplane. It has a bandwidth of 3MHZ. It sells for about \$90.00 & reflects the Sinclair high quality so familiar in commercial usage.

If you are having trouble keeping the magnetic antenna on the roof, try the new Larson. You have to fight with it to get it off the roof. Listening BARRY?

VE3RL is looking for old Railway sounders and telegraph keys. Anything marked with "Western Electric", "GNW", "GT", "Brunell".

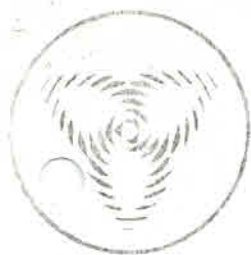
The repeater fund is in fair shape and if the receiver we are considering comes up to expectations, we will be putting it in the old machine this summer.

HOW TO GET THEM

The procedure to follow to obtain call-sign license plates for passenger vehicles, that is those now carrying standard 3 letter, 3 number plates is:

send a letter of application, together with a cheque or money order for \$25.00 payable to "Treasurer of Ontario", to:

The Ministry of Transportation and Communications,

Toronto, Ontario,
Attention: Miss E. Graham

The letter should show your full name, full address and VE3 call sign.

Instructions on what to do on receipt of the plates will be sent with the plates.
