Minutes - Quinte Amateur Radio Club, Inc

January 18, 2006.

- 1) Meeting Called to Order by President Mike Papper at 7:31 PM.
- 2) The following Guests were welcomed to the meeting: Ron Mason VE3GAB
- 3) Repeater Status Report: Repeater was moved to Dave Ward's QTH in November in order to address and repair sensitivity issues. Found 5 watt exciter was putting out about 1.2 watts, but the final amplifier was still putting out close to full power. It was suspected that there were some spurs from the TX which was causing the receive problems. The exciter and final amp was re-tuned and repeater ran about 10 days without problems at Dave's place before putting back to it's permanent site at Queen Vic. But ... Repeater developed some receive problems again at the school. We will once again move the repeater back to Dave's QTH and put it on the air for a few days before 'tinkering' with it to see if we can determine the problem.

Ian VE3EP gave a short report on the PERC repeater VE3TJU. It has been producing some noise on the repeater tail with the final amplifier in service. The Final amp was removed and the repeater has been quieter running at 15 watts, but the noise problem is starting to occur at the lower power level. Troubleshooting the problem is ongoing.

- 4) Correspondence Received:
- a) Bill Milligan VA3WOW has submitted a letter of resignation at Treasurer of the Club.
- b) A letter from Loyalist College (signed by Loyalist President Maureen Piercy) was received thanking us for the donation of the Yaesu FT-2600 2m Transceiver from Al Smardon's estate to the Loyalist Amateur Radio Station VE3ALC.
- 5) ARES Report: Quinte Health Care has requested ARES assistance for the Province wide voltage reduction test to be held Thurs Jan 19. Doug VE3ZDG (Prince Edward County EC) gave an update on the plans to staff the 4 hospitals, Belleville, Trenton, Picton and Bancroft, and that they will try both VHF and HF links between Bancroft and the southern hospitals.

Ron Chapman VE3IVC announced that the Sled Dog Races at Eldorado are to be held Sat Jan 28 at 7AM at the Eldorado Community Center on Highway 62.

- 6) Basic Radio Course: Mike Papper VE3OX is putting together another Basic Course starting Monday March 13, running Mondays and Wednesdays with the exam to be held Monday May 8. Course fee is \$75 and the location to be determined shortly. Contact Mike if you know of someone who is interested in taking the course. Mike is also looking for Instructors.
- 7) Peter Hodgson VE3UR has a quantity of 2006 Durham Radio catalogs available for anyone interested in them. Peter also mentioned Lee McMurter VA3LHM provided some invaluable assistance in assembling the catalog. An 'atta-boy' for Lee! (and a round of applause too!)

- 8) Club Membership List: Tim VE3UO mentioned that as a result of QARC purchasing insurance through RAC and having to maintain a list of RAC and non-RAC members, he has compiled a listing of members on an Excel spreadsheet. We will also put the list in an upcoming 'QRM' Newsletter.
- 9) Appointment of New Treasurer: Motion that Miles LeClair VE3XDX be appointed to be Treasurer for the rest of the 2005-06 term to replace Bill Milligan VA3WOW who has resigned.

Motion made by Ron Chapman VE3IVC, seconded by Peter Hodgson VE3UR. The motion was CARRIED.

The members present gave Bill a round of applause in recognition of Bill's service as both Treasurer and Co-Treasurer with Don Dalrymple VE3DQN previously.
