One again it can be reported that there were no major incidents to deal with, other than one call for additional water at the 5k turnaround point (this sounds familiar!). Repeater Update

- 1) The 12vdc battery backup system for VE3QAR 146.985 Mhz was installed on Monday May 5. The battery is a Canadian Tire 50 amp-hour Gelcell, and switchover and battery charging is accomplished by a West Mountain Radio Super PWRgate PG40S. At this point there is no on-air indication of switchover to DC power, but hopefully this will be dealt with in the near future.
- 2) The repeater now has a 'ker-chunk' filter enabled. When the repeater has been idle for a period of time, a one second sustained carrier will be required before the repeater transmits. Once a QSO starts then the one second carrier isn't required and you can talk normally. After the QSO is completed the repeater goes back to 'sleep' after three minutes.
