

QAR VHF repeater move: Dave VE3OX has received a quote from Guthries Communications and also a good price on heliax from Will VA3JWO what is more in the club's reach. After some discussion a **motion** was made by Dennis VA3DWK to proceed with the installation with Guthries and was seconded by Bob VE3QWB. the motion was **carried**.

Prince Edward Radio Club wind down proposal -

The following is the proposal to wind down the Prince Edward Radio Club (PERC) and donate the club assets to the Quinte Amateur Radio Club (QARC). This is being done as PERC does not have enough members that are willing to fill the various positions required to run the club. This is not being done due to financial reasons as PERC has no financial issues. This proposal must be accepted at a PERC Special General Meeting where a super majority (66%) must approve a special resolution to the wind down of PERC. The proposal must also be accepted by the QARC club before it can be enforced. The Quinte Amateur Radio Club has been chosen as half of the PERC club members are also QARC members. Also, the two clubs have worked closely together over the years and hold the same values as to running the repeater system and social events.

The proposal to QARC is as follows:

- 1. Transfer cash assets which are currently \$3025.64 as of Sept. 14, 2024.
- 2. Transfer ownership of the clubs repeaters located at Base 31. list to be provided.
- 3. Transfer ownership of the clubs field day equipment. List to be provided.
- 4. Transfer ownership of PERC miscellaneous equipment. List to be provided.
- 5. Transfer PERC official paper documents.
- 6. Transfer PERC's domain (peradio.ca) to QARC.
- 7. Transfer PERC's Google Workspace account to QARC.
- 8. Transfer PERC callsigns VE3TJU and VA3PEC to QARC.
- 9. Offer PERC members without QARC membership a 6 month membership from January 1,2025 til June 30,2025 at a prorated price to align with the QARC year end.
- 10. Appoint an emergency coordinator (EC) to liason with the Prince Edward municipality.
- 11. Appoint a repeater manager for Base 31 repeaters VE3TJU and VA3PEC.
- 12. QARC to Sponsor Robert VA3KRJ as the accredited Examiner.
- 13. There are no known liabilities at this time.

A motion was made to <u>accept</u> PERC's proposal by Matthew VE3FL and was seconded by Attila VE3KAS. the motion was carried.

Dave VE3OX adjourned the meeting.

Repeater Callsign VA3JWO changes to VE3RTY

Will Olendy VA3JWO recently obtained the VE3RTY callsign which was the call of VA3HD Sean Dickinson's (SK) repeater system in Colborne. Will's local repeaters now have the VE3RTY callsign associated with them which is the Chuckery Hill repeater on 145.37 MHz and his repeater in Madoc on 146.865 MHz.

VE3QAR Repeater Update

When the QARC UHF repeater on 444.475 MHz comes back on the air it will have the callsign **VE3BEL**. This is to distinguish it from the two meter repeater on 146.985 MHz as they are in different locations.

The UHF repeater was taken off the air to keep the VHF repeater operational at a reduced coverage when we vacated the Queen Victoria School site at the end of June.

The two meter repeater antenna and feedline is scheduled to be installed by Guthries Communications (https://www.guthries.com/) on the Police Tower in Belleville on Monday November 18. The tower is 200' (61m) tall, and we will be at 100' (31m). The plan is to install the antenna and feedline first, test it, and then move the repeater to the new location. If all goes well we should be operational at our new location the same week. The two meter repeater will keep the VE3QAR callsign.
