

The meeting was brought to order by club President Dave Ackerman VE3OX.

Fortunately, we have no silent keys to report.

Dave VE3OX welcomed visitors and Guests in attendance including **Brad Yhard VA3CBU**, **John Mackay VE3BQH**, and club member **Tim Boone VE3WGJ** who is attending his first in person meeting. Nice to see you all at the meeting. Also in attendance is **Staff Sgt Jeremy Ashley** from the City of Belleville Police Service who thanked the club for it's ongoing support of their Halloween Safe Streets program.

A motion was made by Dennis VA3DWK to accept the October minutes as published in the news letter and was seconded by Tim VE3WGJ. The motion was carried.

A motion was made by Attila VA3KAS to accept his **Treasurer's Report** stating 73 paid members in good standing with an account balance of \$7139.00. The motion was seconded by Eric VA3DOO. The motion was **carried**.

Bob Moore VE3QWB reported that we received a letter from the **CNIB** requesting a donation. Dennis VA3DWK made a **motion** that we donate \$100 as we have in past years. It was seconded by Bob VE3QWB. The motion was **carried**.

Christmas Dinner is booked to go ahead with the Tractor Club at the Allisonville Elks lodge **Nov 30**^{th.} Tickets are \$30.00 per person. Dave VE3OX has 15 people booked so far. Dave VE3OX reports that the VE3QAR repeater move is scheduled for Monday Nov. 25th. The installation company is providing the antenna and clips to secure the coax to the tower. We got a super buy on enough heliax and connectors from Wil VA3JWO which will help tremendously with keeping costs down. The quote provided was for two days labour but Dave is hoping we will get it done in a day. The only concern is pulling the heliax through the conduit as there are several feeds already in the conduit. The Belleville Police service has supplied us with space on their racking system for the repeater and cavities. The facility also has a UPS system with diesel generator back up so we should see uninterrupted service. We also have access to internet for Allstar. Hans VE3OR asked about security and how we access the repeater for maintenance and Dave suggested We may be able to get access by visiting the front desk otherwise we will need to book an appointment to gain access.

Dave VE3OX also indicated that the **UHF repeater** will be located back at Dave's residence. Once it's back running, we will have to decide if it will be analog or C4FM.

Matthew VE3FL Reported on the wind down of the PERC club with the club members passing the resolution to wind down the club. Work is being done by Matthew to transfer bank accounts, call signs, web addresses, and Robert VA3KRJ as QARC examiner. Matthew is also sorting through the equipment he has stored in his basement to compile a list to present to the club. Bob VE3QWB thanked Matthew on behalf of the club for all his hard work getting this accomplished.

Peter VE3UR spoke about a form he circulated a while ago for anyone interested in **ARES** (ACS). He has blank forms with him this evening if anyone is interested. The form lists your personal information and a list of equipment you have to utilize in an emergency.

VE3QAR Repeater Update

The VHF repeater is in service at our new location at the Belleville Police Service, But it appears that 'Murphy' has moved in with us. While the footprint seems to be improved from what we had at Queen Victoria school there are a few problems- some receive insensitivity, especially to the south, and some occasional noise bursts and locking on, especially during some of our Nets. The repeater antenna was installed on the north side of the tower and a bit of a shadow was expected to the south, but it appears that there is a lot of broadband noise in the immediate vicinity which is also responsible for some of the insensitivity on the receive side. The good news is that there is nothing inside the Police radio room causing the noise, which means the bad news is that the noise issue is outside in the vicinity of our antenna. The CTCSS tone was changed to 91.5 Hz to get away from 118.8 which is close to the second harmonic of the power line frequency of 60 hz. While this appears to have reduced the problems slightly, it is still there. The Club would also like to thank Will Olendy VA3JWO who checked our installation and our duplexer with a spectrum analyser which determined there were no issues inside the radio room causing our problems, but there there is a high ambient noise level outside.

When the QARC UHF repeater on 444.475 MHz comes back on the air it will have the callsign **VE3BEL**. This will distinguish it from the two meter repeater on 146.985 MHz as they are in different locations. The repeater will be located at VE3OX Dave's QTH and we hope to improve the antenna set up slightly to improve the coverage. We will also look at putting the repeater back on C4FM.
