

Brad tried to address some issues related to Ham radio bands and what the technology of the governments proposed system may cause Amateur radio enthusiasts, including the lack of consultation with RAC ... but his questions for the most part went unanswered. Brad also noticed that the panel presenting were not very familiar with affairs and general knowledge of the Ham Radio world ... His general feeling was that DND may be only following through their own process of required steps to have the project rubber stamped. However Brad does not seem deterred and will continue to search for answers by making contacts, presenting to various clubs and consulting with RAC and other groups . Brad will keeps us informed on his findings . All present appreciated and thanked Brad for his effort and diligence .


The meeting was **adjourned** at 8:40 pm.
